Middle/High School Parent General Information for Students Enrolling Under the Provisions of the Military Compact

Nevada Revised Statutes 388.470 & 392.040

This information is provided to parents/guardians as an overview of the Military Compact. For more information regarding the Provisions of the Military Compact, please speak with the clerk, office manager, or an administrator at your child's school.

- <u>Grade Level Placement:</u> Students who have satisfactorily completed the prerequisite grade level shall be placed in the next higher grade level, regardless of age.
- <u>Records:</u> Parents/guardians may provide unofficial transcript/records to the new school for the purpose of grade-level placement and course selection. The new school will request official records from the sending school. The sending school will process and furnish the official educational records within 10 days or such time as reasonable.
- ▶ <u>Immunizations:</u> Parents/guardians shall provide proof of immunizations (completed or in process of receiving) within 30 school days after enrollment.
- **Special Education:** Parents/guardians should provide a copy of the student's individualized education program when registering. Students who were eligible for special education services in their previous school district may be entitled to short-term, comparable special education services in CCSD, until such time as their continuing need for special education services in Nevada is determined.
- ▶ <u>Program Placement:</u> Schools shall initially honor placement of the student in educational programs based on assessments from the sending state or participation in like programs (eg. GATE, ELL).
- ▶ <u>Course Placement Flexibility:</u> CCSD shall have flexibility in waiving course or program prerequisites as well as preconditions for placement in courses or programs.
- <u>Attendance:</u> Students shall be granted additional excused absences to visit his/her parent or legal guardian when relating to leave or deployment.
- **Extracurricular Activities:** CCSD shall facilitate opportunities for transitioning students of military families to be included in extracurricular activities, regardless of application deadlines, to the extent they are otherwise qualified.
- ▶ <u>Testing:</u> CCSD and Nevada Department will review, with an enrolling 12th grade student, possible alternatives to the high school proficiency exam.
- <u>High School Graduation</u>: School administrators shall waive specific courses required for graduation if similar course work has been completed at another school. If a waiver is not granted, the student shall be provided alternate means of acquiring the required course work so the student may graduate on time.

If a student transfers to CCSD immediately before, beginning, or during his/her senior year and is ineligible to graduate from CCSD after all alternatives have been considered, the sending state and CCSD shall ensure the receipt of a diploma from the sending state if the student meets the graduation requirements of the sending state.
